Certification Anniversary Date: February 24, 2017 It is also your responsibility to annually submit a No Change Affidavit and Personal Net Worth (Form 413) to DeIDOT, available on the DBE Program website: www.DBE.DelDot.gov. This affidavit is to be submitted to DeIDOT every year on your firm's anniversary date and shall specifically state that the firm continues to meet business size criteria and the overall gross receipts cap. Any firm that fails to provide any of the aforementioned in a timely manner will be deemed to have failed to cooperate under §26.109(c) and is subject to immediate disqualification from the DBE Program. The DBE Program reserves the right to rescind certification if any information upon which it is based proves to be false, inaccurate, or misleading.
