Congratulations! In accordance with the Department of Transportation Rules and Regulations, 49 CFR, Part 23 and 26, the Mississippi Unified Certification Program Committee has approved Airport Concession Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (ACDBE) status for your firm. Your firm's name will be added to Mississippi's UCP list of certified ACDBE firms at [www.gomdot.com](http://www.gomdot.com). This ACDBE Certification is valid for three years pending your firm's continued eligibility for the program and fulfilling the annual reporting requirements under CFR 49 Part 26.83(j).

You must provide written notification within 30 days of the occurrence or the change. If you fail to make timely notification of changes, you may be considered as having failed to cooperate under Section 26.109 (c) and subject to the removal of your ACDBE status.

ACDBE Certification is NOT a guarantee of work, but enables your firm to compete for and perform Airport Concessions opportunities at airports in Mississippi as an ACDBE.



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

This certification is renewable in three years on **April 3, 2020**. Renewal forms will be sent to you at least 90 days prior to the renewal date of your certification. However, on the first and second anniversary dates of your firm's certification, on **April 3, 2018** and the following year, you must submit to JMAA a signed, notarized affidavit, affirming that there have been no changes in the firm's circumstances affecting its ability to meet the requirements for certification. An Annual Update Affidavit will be sent to you prior to the above referenced anniversary dates. **It is your responsibility to ensure that your firm's certification remains current.**

The Mississippi UCP reserves the right to withdraw this certification if at any time it is determined your certification was knowingly obtained by false, misleading or incorrect information. The Mississippi UCP also reserves the right to request additional information and/or conduct an on-site visit at any time during the certification period to verify any documentation submitted in the application for certification. By accepting certification your firm hereby consents to the examination of its books and documents by the Mississippi UCP as needed.
