Dear Allison Sheffield de Agüero,

Congratulations! Diversified Energy Supply has been certified by the Utah Unified Certification Program (UUCP) as a **Disadvantaged Business Enterprise** (DBE). The Salt Lake City Department of Airports is a certifying partner of the UUCP and will maintain your file during the life of Diversified Energy Supply DBE certification. In accordance with the federal DBE regulations, which are found at 49 C.F.R. Part 26, Diversified Energy Supply is certified in the following areas:

221210 - Distribution of Natural Gas

424720 - Petroleum and Petroleum Products Merchant Wholesalers (except Bulk Stations and Terminals)

Diversified Energy Supply certification shall remain valid, unless and until it has been removed in accordance with procedures set forth in 49 C.F.R. 26.87. In order to remain certified, Diversified Energy Supply must submit annually, on the anniversary of your DBE certification, a No Change Affidavit. This document is a sworn affidavit affirming that there have been no changes in the firm's circumstances affecting its size, disadvantaged status, ownership or the control requirements of the regulations, or any material changes to contact information, ownership, and/or expansion of services, must be communicated to the UUCP within 30 days of the change. Failure to provide these changes could result in your firm being removed from the UUCP DBE directory. The UUCP reserves the right to re-evaluate a firm's certification status at anytime that the UUCP determines such re-evaluation is warranted.


Annually, this office may send a courtesy reminder(s) to DBE firms prior to the renewal date. However, it is the responsibility of the majority DBE owner(s) to ensure the renewal package is received by the anniversary date of your certification. Additionally, if at any time there is a change in circumstances, during the course of your firm's certification period that affects your ability to meet size, disadvantaged status, ownership, or control criteria or any material change in the information provided in your initial application, you must provide written notification to the Utah Unified Certification Program (UUCP) within thirty (30) days of the occurrence of change. This includes business address, telephone number and email address changes must be reported. Failure to provide these changes may result in your firm being removed from the UUCP DBE Directory and is cause for decertification proceedings by this office pursuant to 49 CFR 26.109(c).
